Be ready for our classroom to be decorated with lots of Halloween themed art created by the children. The children will learn about and listen to some compositions by 'The Beatles' and they will learn colors in Spanish. Color Tablet boxes 1 and 2 will be used to introduce the names of colors in English and Spanish.
